Order following the investigation of an incident with a trolley falling from a lifting beam during demounting on Åsgard B on 13 March 2019

We have completed our investigation of the above-mentioned incident. Our report was sent to you together with the notice of an order on 26 June 2019. We have identified breaches of the regulations, see section 8.1 of the investigation report, and, in accordance with the notice given in our letter of 26 June 2019, you are hereby issued with the following order.

Pursuant to section 69 of the framework regulations on administrative decisions, see section 21 of the management regulations on follow-up and sections 20 litera b, 29, 30 and 92 of the activities regulations on start-up and operation of facilities, planning, safety clearance of activities, and lifting operations respectively, Equinor is ordered to

- *ensure that the preconditions and necessary expertise for safety clearance of rigging and lifting operations are provided on Åsgard B.*

See sections 8.1.1, 8.1.2, 8.1.3, 8.1.4, and 8.1.6 of the report.

The deadline for compliance with the order is 1 October 2019. We must be informed when the order has been carried out.

An appeal can be made against this decision pursuant to section 28 of the Public Administration Act. The deadline is three weeks from the receipt of this letter. A possible appeal will be heard by the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs, but must be submitted to us. Further information on the procedure for making an appeal can be obtained from us.

This decision must be made known to elected officers for the workforce, including the safety delegates, pursuant to section 18-6, paragraph 8, of the Working Environment Act.
