Order following investigation of condensate leak on GjØa 21 June 2017

We conducted an investigation from 26 June-11 December 2017 into the incident involving a condensate leak on GjØa.

We refer to the notice of an order and the dispatch of our report. In accordance with the notice, the following order is hereby issued.

Pursuant to section 69 of the framework regulations on administrative decisions, see section 5 of the management regulations on barriers, Engie is ordered to take the necessary measures to ensure that safety-critical equipment is operated, tested and maintained in a way which ensures the performance of the barriers at all times. See chapter 7.1 .1 in the report.

The deadline for compliance with this order is set to 16 February 2018. We must be informed when the order has been complied with.

An appeal can be made against this decision pursuant to section 28 of the Public Administration Act. The deadline is three weeks from the receipt of this letter. A possible appeal will be heard by the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs, but must be submitted to us. Further information on the procedure for making an appeal can be obtained from us.

This decision must be made known to union officials, including the safety delegates, pursuant to section 18-6, paragraph 8, of the Working Environment Act.
