## Order following investigation of personal injuries from H<sub>2</sub>S exposure at Sture on 12 October 2016

We refer to the notice of an order and dispatch of the report of our investigation into the incident at Sture on 12 October 2016. In accordance with the notice, we hereby issue the following order:

Pursuant to section 69 of the framework regulations on administrative decisions, see sections 4, 5 and 6 of the management regulations on risk reduction, barriers and management of health, safety and the environment respectively, we order Statoil to take the necessary measures to ensure that activities which could expose personnel to harmful concentrations of  $H_2S$  or other noxious substances at Sture can be conducted in an acceptable manner. See section 5.1.1 of the report. The effect of the measures must be verified.

The deadline for complying with this order is 1 June 2017. We must be notified when the order has been complied with.

The decision can be appealed pursuant to section 28 of the Public Administration Act. The deadline is three weeks from the receipt of this letter. The appellate authority is the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs, but a possible appeal must be submitted to us. Further details about the opportunities to appeal and the appeals procedure can be obtained from us.

The decision must be made known to employee representatives, including safety delegates, pursuant to section 18, subsection 6, paragraph 18 of the Working Environment Act.
